Care + Cleaning NATURAL FIBER CARPETS & RUGS (Jute / Hemp / Coir / Sisal)

- Natural fiber carpet and rugs inherently have loose fibers and knots. Regularly vacuum on low power settings with NO beater bar, making sure to vacuum from different angles.
- Loose threads on the face of the carpet or rug should be trimmed with household scissors. To avoid unraveling or damaging the carpet or rug, threads on the face should never be pulled.
- Spills should be gently blotted with a clean, undyed/white cloth to absorb as much of the spill as possible and prevent spreading. Work from the outer edges of the spill towards to center. For stubborn stains, use a professional cleaning service that specializes in Natural Fiber carpets and rugs. Do not dry clean, as strong cleaning chemicals may damage or fade the material.
- Natural fibers are more prone to staining. J Leigh carpets recommends having your Natural Fiber rug sealed to provide extra stain protection and easier care.

Fiber Protection must be reapplied to any portions of an area rug that has been spot cleaned. Wait until fibers are fully dry before applying Fiber Protection spray. Rug will need 24 hours for fiber protection to cure before using.
